

Trainee Pioneer Worker
Full time or part time (depending on funding)

Purpose of Role:

Our church exists to spread the good news of Jesus Christ to our local area and to serve our church family. We are looking for someone to work within an established leadership team, and alongside the Pastor, to oversee and develop our community engagement, and seek and support opportunities to reach out to the local community.

The role:

1. It is a trainee role for those looking to go into full time Christian ministry.
2. Full support and supervision will be provided by the Pastor and other church staff.
3. As a trainee role it will specify time for a theological training course (like the Union Gdip, Resource South Wales, etc) – agreed by the elders of the church.
4. The role will have a focus on pioneer work, that is, evangelistic and missional work. This will include existing church ministries, but also encourage new avenues of community engagement
5. In light of Ephesians 4:11-12 ministry, the role will require the ability to disciple believers, and encourage and equip them to engage with the community and share the gospel.
6. In order to be a pioneer the person must have an entrepreneurial attitude, and be able to assess needs and opportunities to serve the community.
